Emil' (home name Milya) was born in Kiev in 1902, as follows from Case C and metric record:

ЧАСТЬ І. О РОДИВШИХСЯ. Число и мѣсяцъ рожденія и обрѣ-Кто родан Кто соверродился. Состояние отда, имена занія. Myzeckaro KOB CHY, шалъ обрядъ отда и матери. Христі-Еврейобрѣзанія. ABE0 анскій. CEIH. Jun 14 Proticener VHALLO Jell

We know nothing about his education, but we know for sure that he moved to Leningrad. There are some problems with interpretation of the Leningrad phone books which probably used the abbreviation  $\text{Em}(\Im M)$  for two different names, Emil' and Emmanuil. Sometimes  $\text{Emman}(\Im M M a H)$  was used for the latter name.

Unambigous information about Emil's address Furmanova 30-7 (1956) is found in StPetersburg burial archive: this address is indicated in respect to the funeral of Dina P. Sokol, his aunt (Emil' took care of her up to the last moment, and was registered as a person responsible for her grave). As Furmanova street was the temporary name of Gagarinskaya street (during 1952-1998), we can probably assign the address Gagarinskaya 30 indicated in 1925 - 1931 phone books to Emil', despite it is mentioned either for Em. M. Tsyrlin, or for Emman. M. Tsyrlin. Telephone number is available in 1929 - 1931 phone books: 239-18. In 1925 and 1926, Em. M.Tsirlin is affiliated with

some military financial organization (военно-окружной финансово-контрольный отдел). Emil' passed away in 1966 in Leningrad.

Emil's wife was Judif' Aronovna (1904 - 1988), as it follows from the monument. In 2017, we found that Vladilen Emil'evich Tsyrlin (born 1925) and his son Igor Vladilenovich Tsyrlin (born 1948) still live in StPetersburg. Igor Vladilenovich confirmed that Emil' Moiseevich was his grandfather (identification started from discussion of grave at Preobrazhenskoe cemetary). Unfortunately Vladilen Emil'evich is unhealthy now, and cannot remember any family details. Igor Vladilenovich has very limited information because their connections with Tsirlins were very rare after Emil's death.
